Booking terms & conditions: (Updated April 2020)

- ❖ Courses are only open to Chue Foundation members.
- ❖ By filling in the [online booking form](#) you are applying to join a course. For all courses that Grand Master Chan teaches, he will select the appropriate students.
- ❖ Successful students will be informed of their place on a course after Grand Master Chan has confirmed their place and agreed to confirm the course. There is no specific timeframe for place and course confirmation.
- ❖ There needs to be a minimum of 8 successful students to confirm a course. If you book travel arrangements before the course is confirmed to you, then you do so at your own risk. We do not hold any responsibility for any travel expenses the student may have incurred.
- ❖ We respect 'first come first served' booking orders in the event of limited places on courses. We hold the right of entry for all courses.
- ❖ Attending a Chue style course means that the student recognises and respects the rule that the contents of that Chue style course may not be copied, transmitted, reproduced, published, taught, uploaded online, posted on social media (Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, etc.), shared or divulged in any way, be it from the handouts/notes/photos from class or by oral transmission, to any person other than the students on the same course. The student may not record in class. Computers, laptops, notepads or any other electrical equipment are not authorised for use in the classroom. - ❖ No translators are allocated to courses. If translation is required it is according to 'The Terms and Conditions for Teachers and Translators' document approved by Grand Master Chan.
- ❖ Selective course notes from Master Pamela Forsyth are only available to students that have attended a course but missed a specific section of teaching.

Cancellation:

- ❖ If a student has a place on a course and needs to cancel that place, then we require 1 months' notice. We can then offer that place to another student.

- ❖ In the event of cancellation or change of dates for a course, we do not hold any responsibility for any travel expenses the student may have incurred. We always recommend that the student have valid travel and medical insurance. We do our utmost to keep to advertised course schedules.
- ❖ We reserve the right to change or modify the prices and general conditions of any course at any time. Prices are subject to and issued by the Chue Foundation Guidelines for Schools and Teachers. Whenever possible, Enerchi will try to maintain quoted prices and course conditions.

Registration, timings, refreshments & lunch arrangements:

- ❖ Registration is at 09.30 on the first day of a course. Courses will then start at 09.00 and finish at 16.00 daily, unless otherwise stated.
- ❖ Two refreshment breaks per day & lunches are your own responsibility. They are not included in the course fee.
- ❖ During a course the student is liable for their own behaviour and wellbeing. It is advisable to have adequate personal liability insurance.
